SAFETY REPORT:

Chief Jacobs gave his safety report. The safety committee last met on the 25rd of November and will meet next on the 27th of January, 2016. One accident reported since the last meeting, resulting in minor damage to E94 mirrors.

FIRE DISTRICT BUSINESS:

Executive Search Committee:

Commissioner Taggart states that the search appears to be moving forward and there are no updates.

Fire District Planning Group:

Commissioner Martin recounted that a planning workshop had taken place and discussions had been had regarding streamlining stations and replacing or rebuilding aging apparatus.

Review Strategic Plan:

Commissioner Martin advised that while parts of the strategic plan had been reviewed and discussed during the recent workshop, the board should consider meeting to update the plan after the first of next year.

Adopt List of 2016 Holidays:

The board reviewed the proposed list of Holidays for the 2016 calendar year. **Motion by Commissioner Berg to approve** the list of holidays, seconded by Petty. **Motion passed** unanimously.

2016 Board Assignments:

The board discussed various positions available for assignment in 2016 and who previously filled the positions. The completed list of board assignments is located on page 4. **Motion by Commissioner Taggart to approve** the board assignments, seconded by Gianatasio. **Motion passed** unanimously.

2016 Cost of Living pay increases:

The board reviewed a proposal to increase the pay for office and part time personnel by 1.3% for FY2016. **Motion by Commissioner Berg** to approve the pay increase, seconded by Taggart. **Motion passed** unanimously.

COMMISSIONER COMMENTS:

Commissioner Taggart directed the board chair to request a schedule from Interim Chief Gillespie. Commissioner Berg asked to review a MOB summary report for 2015. Commissioner Taggart shared an idea for compiling information from commissioners' conferences and seminars and making the information available in a digital library format. Commissioner Berg noted that he had not been informed yet about the upcoming WFCA conference in February. Commissioner Martin noted that it is not required to sign in at the meeting with a signature, and for the sake of identity protection, a printed name on the sign in sheet should suffice. Commissioner Martin advised that she had begun communicating with the Mayor about informal meetings after the first of the year. Commissioner Martin also commended Commissioner Gianatasio for keeping the board apprised of the interest due for the radio payment and will communicate with Chief Gillespie about options for reducing that liability. Assistant Chief Jacobs advised that he will email the board his thoughts on Station 96.
