Drywall repair (from plumbing fix)	\$5,000.00
Water Heater	\$3,929.00
Total cost to fix pipes and replace water heater	\$23,825.33

The plumbing quote is to replace all drainage lines in the building to the concrete level. This was the suggestion of the plumber.

Below is a picture of an elbow that was leaking. The city has replaced the elbow. This is why the city requesting for all the plumbing be replaced.



Video inspection of the lines under the concrete showed no concerns. This is good news and leads me to believe replacing all the indoor plumbing at this time may be premature.

The hot water heater did not function properly when first used by the city. The Plumber recommended replacing it. However, it is properly functioning at this time. See attached photo. Water heater was manufactured in 2002.
