FIRE DISTRICT BUSINESS:

Washougal School District Presentation:

Dr. Rebecca Von Duering presented an informational overview of a proposal from the WSD Pathways Program that would see the leasing of Station 95 to the Pathways program. The program provides continuing education for adults with developmental disabilities, and station 95 would provide a variety of facilities that would enable the administration of the curriculum.

Consider Resolution No. 222-05162017 Closing of Petty Cash Account:

Secretary Jones explained that with the transition to new financial software, the District now has the ability to write petty cash checks from the same software as accounts payable and payroll, making a separate checking account redundant. The money would be transferred to the general fund. Motion by Commissioner Martin to approve the resolution, seconded by Commissioner Petty. Motion Passed.

Consider Purchase Request for Ladders:

Chief Carnes explained that two ladders on first out apparatus are in need of repair, and the cost of repair is as much as purchasing a new ladder. Firefighter Prasch determined the cause of the wear and has worked with Chief Jacobs to modify the ladder racks so as to prevent future similar damage. Commissioner Gianatasio inquired about the feasibility of using ladders from other apparatus until the new E91 apparatus arrives. Chief Carnes and Captain Troutman advised that these are the last available in service ladders. Motion by Commissioner Martin to approve the purchase request, seconded by Commissioner Berg. Commissioners Berg, Martin, Taggart and Petty vote yea, Commissioner Gianatasio votes nay. Motion Passed.
