- I had a meeting with the DNR Supervisor to review our expectations with their use of Station 93. They plan to start using Station 93 on Friday, July 1.
- I attended an Ops Chiefs meeting on Tuesday, June 28 at Station 21 in Ridgefield. We continue to work on the Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) procedure. We are modifying it slightly so that it fits into our current "Blue Card" Incident Command system. Once we are done with it, it will move to the Training Chiefs group for implementation. We also discussed operational plans for each agency in preparation for the July 4 holiday weekend.
- The Countywide outdoor burn ban goes into effect on July 15.
- We completed our annual fire hose testing on Friday, June 24. Captain Burch states that we only lost two sticks of hose this year. One 100 ft. section of large diameter supply hose (LDH) and one 50 ft. section of 1 ¾" attack hose. Commissioner Hofmaster graced us with his presence on Friday so that he could see how the hose testing is done.
- ECFR fire crews will be training on vehicle stabilization and extrication procedures this month.
- The second running of the fire chief recruitment has been completed. The application process closed on June 27. Unfortunately, we did not receive any new packets. We will be discussing a plan moving forward at tomorrow's planning workshop.
