East County Fire and Rescue is conducting a recruitment process in order to establish an eligibility list to fill future Part-time Firefighter/EMT positions.

Salary Range: \$12.50 - \$16.00 per hour DOQ

Open Period: Accepting continuous applications

Position Information: Part-Time

Hours of Employment: 0700-0700 on a scheduled A, B, or C shift. Every sixth day.

Benefits: East County Fire & Rescue provides employees with benefits including, but not limited to, Public Employee Retirement System (PERS), employee assistance program; Personal Time Off program; and training opportunities.

Examples of Duties: Part time Firefighter / EMT performs daily station duties to include equipment and facilities maintenance, daily fire and medical training, and provide public information and assistance. Responsibilities also include incident response, apparatus operation, report writing and fire ground operations.

Minimum Qualifications

- 18 years of age by time of hire
- Prior experience of minimum one year paid firefighter or two years volunteer - or an acceptable combination of both
- Washington EMT certification (or ability to obtain within 3 months of hire date)
- HAZMAT Awareness Certified (must obtain HAZMAT OPS cert within 6 months of hire date)
- Emergency Vehicle Incident Prevention Certified (or equivalent)
- Authorized to work in the US
- Proof of current CPAT certification (within previous 12 months)

- Washington State EMT-B
- HAZMAT OPS Certified
- IFSAC Instructor I
- IFSAC Firefighter I, II
- NIMS ICS 100, 200, 700
- NWCG FF 2 Red Card

IMPORTANT: Your application packet will be scored (25% of overall score). You must provide documentation of all classes, certifications, experience, and education in order for it to apply toward your score. For example, if you claim to be HAZMAT OPS certified you will receive no credit for it unless a certificate (copy) is provided.

Testing Process

There will be no written exam. All qualified applications will be held until a part-time opening occurs. At that time East Co. Fire and Rescue will schedule oral board interviews for as many applicants as necessary for the number of job openings.

HIRING PROCESS SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

As part time positions become available, oral interviews will be scheduled. Following oral interviews, a list will be established and a final chief's interview will be scheduled.

Upon conditional offer of employment, a background investigation will be conducted and will consist of a comprehensive investigation of your education and employment history (including a criminal and DMV review), drug screening, and a medical examination.
