A resolution providing for appointment of committees for and against the August 6, 2024 fire levy lid lift.


WHEREAS the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 29A32.280 requires the board of fire commissioners formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments for approval of the lid lift ballot measure and to formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments rejection of the lid lift ballot measure, and


WHEREAS the district solicited interest from individuals supporting and opposing the fire levy lid lift by advertising in the Camas Washougal Post Record newspaper and through the district's social media channels, and

WHEREAS three residents of the district requested to be appointed to the committee to prepare arguments for approval of the lid lift ballot measure and no residents of the district requested appointment to prepare arguments opposing the ballot measure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of East County Fire & Rescue appoint Bob Peterson, Mike Carmichael, and Richard Hamby to the committee to prepare arguments for approval of the August 6, 2024 lid lift ballot measure. As no residents requested appointment to the committee preparing arguments opposing the ballot measure, no appointments are made to that committee.
