SUBJECT: Health and Safety Officer

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NFPA 1521 Standard for Fire Department Safety Officer

POLICY:

- (1) The duties and responsibilities of the Fire District Health and Safety Officer shall include, but are not limited to:
 - (a) Plan and coordinate safety activities.
 - (b) Work closely with the Safety Committee.
 - (c) Ensure accidents are investigated.
 - (d) Devise corrective measures to prevent accidents.
- (2) Realizing safety training and recordkeeping are management's responsibility, the Fire District Health and Safety Officer shall ensure the following requirements are being met:
 - (a) Ensure safety training for all employees.
 - (b) Ensure safety directives are complied with.
 - (c) Ensure that records are kept centrally, including but not limited to the following:
 - Accidents: (i)
 - (ii) Injuries;
 - Inspections; (iii)
 - (iv) Exposures:
 - (v) Medical monitoring;
 - Safety meetings; (vi)
 - Apparatus; (vii)
 - Equipment; (viii)
 - Protective clothing; (ix)
 - Other fire District safety activities. (x)
- (3) The Fire District Health and Safety Officer, through the Fire Chief, shall have the authority and responsibility to identify and recommend correction of safety and health hazards.
- (4) The Fire District Health and Safety Officer shall maintain a liaison with Staff Officers regarding recommended changes in equipment, procedures, and recommended methods to eliminate unsafe practices and reduce existing hazardous conditions.

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
