- Have been participating in several teleconference meetings with the Clark County Fire Chiefs, the Operation Chiefs and with the MPD's Office to stay on top of the COVID-19 response.
- Crews have been doing a very nice job in keeping themselves safe by following the response protocols set forth by the MPD's Office. CWFD's supplies ECFR with the PPE needed to protect our firefighters and our patients. The inventory of PPE is holding up so far.
- The Clark County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is fully operational now and is organizing an avenue to order, receive and distribute through CWFD, our PPE for the duration of the COVID event.
- The County Ops Chiefs are working to secure a single source for COVID testing of our responders
 if it were needed. Work continues on nailing down the details and the guidelines of how that
 will look. ECFR does have an infectious disease policy that is updated and in place.
