Second Amendment to Purchase and Sale Agreement Dated October 2, 2019 between

City of Washougal (Buyer) and East County Fire and Rescue (Seller) 211 39th Street, Washougal, WA

Added language <u>underlined</u> Deleted language strikethrough

Closing: The parties agree to extend the Closing Date to thirty (30) days following the first date Seller has quieted the title exception identified by Buyer, or thirty (30) days following March 31, 2020, whichever date first occurs.

Section 5 of the Purchase and Sale Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

5. Title Insurance. Within three (3) days after the Execution Date, Seller shall instruct a title company selected by Seller (the "Title Company") to deliver to Buyer a preliminary title report from the Title Company (the "Preliminary Report), showing the status of Seller's title to the Property, together with complete and legible copies of all documents shown therein as exceptions to title ("Exceptions"). Buyer shall have ten (10) days after receipt of a copy of the Preliminary Report and Exceptions within which to give notice in writing to Seller of any objection to such title or to any liens or encumbrances affecting the Property. Within ten (10) days after receipt of such notice from Buyer, Seller shall give Buyer written notice of whether it is willing and able to remove the objected-to Exceptions. Without the need for objection by Buyer, Seller shall, with respect to liens and encumbrances that can be satisfied and released by the payment of money, eliminate such exceptions to title on or before Closing. On or before the last day for Buyer to approve the results of the General Conditions set forth in Section 2.1 above (the "Title Contingency Date") March 31, 2020, Buyer shall elect whether to: (i) purchase the Property subject to those objected-to Exceptions which Seller is not willing or able to remove; or (ii) terminate this Agreement. If Buyer fails to give Seller notice of Buyer's election, then such inaction shall be deemed to be Buyer's election to terminate this Agreement. On or before the Closing Date (defined below), Seller shall remove all Exceptions to which Buyer objected and which Seller agreed, or is deemed to have agreed, to remove. All remaining Exceptions set forth in the Preliminary Report and those Exceptions caused by or agreed to by Buyer shall be deemed "Permitted Exceptions".

Except as so amended, the Purchase and Sale agreement between the parties is hereby reinstated.
