RE: Incorrect Revenue Distribution

Honorable Treasurer Lasher,

The Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR), discovered an incorrect distribution of \$560,091.59 of trust revenue to Clark County. Please accept my apologies for the impact to your office and the county, this was an unintentional error.

The following background information may help in understanding the error. DNR manages approximately 3 million acres of state trust lands in Washington. State trust lands are distinctive in that they are managed to produce non-tax revenue for the designated beneficiary of a given parcel of state land. State trust lands provide revenue through activities such as selling timber harvesting rights and leasing lands for a variety of purposes including agriculture, communication sites, and mining. We also enter into contracts for the removal of rock, which was the origin of this error.

The two most common types of trust lands in Washington are Common School trust lands and State Forest trust lands. Revenue from Common School trust lands is distributed to the State's Common School Construction Fund to support K-12 schools. Revenue from State Forest trust lands is distributed to the specific county where the land is located and provides funding for county services as well as for junior taxing districts such as school districts, emergency services, and libraries.

DNR currently has a rock removal contract in Clark County, referred to as the Livingston Quarry (see attached map). The contract, 32-079404, for this quarry with Clark County Public Works has been in place since 2007. The contract area for the quarry includes both Common School trust lands and State Forest trust lands. A recent review of the Livingston Quarry contract

revealed the revenue was distributed based on the land encompassed by the contract area instead of based on the trust land from which the rock came throughout the term of the contract. The rock came solely from Common School trust land. Attached is a map of Livingston Quarry that shows the rock removal area in relationship to the trust land ownership.

As trust manager, DNR needs to correct this error and deliver the revenue to the correct beneficiary. I am requesting repayment of the State Forest trust revenue that was mistakenly distributed to the county including the revenue the county subsequently distributed to the local taxing districts per RCW 79.64.110.

Based on a review of receipts completed by both Clark County Treasurer's Office and DNR's Finance Division, Clark County received revenue from 2007 to 2018 totaling \$560,091.59 encompassing portions of Tax Code Areas 117017 and 114009. Included is an attachment of a spreadsheet detailing the payments.

I recognize that correcting this mistake could take a little time. I am available, along with other staff, to work with you to obtain the best resolution for Clark County. It is my understanding that our staff has been working with your Deputy Treasurer, Sara Lowe, and Colleen DeGroat at the county. Once again, I apologize for this error and look forward to it being resolved.

#### East County Fire and Rescue Talks Finances

Fire District Pursues Ways to Save Money

CAMAS, WASH. – East County Fire and Rescue is asking voters to consider a Fire Levy lid lift during the November General Election. If approved, the lid lift would return the Fire Levy to \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed property value – the same rate it was in 2008.

Funding would be used to maintain emergency service levels, improve firefighter training, maintain facilities, and repair equipment and apparatus. These items are necessary to maintain the community's insurance rating, which affects the insurance premiums that home and business owners pay.

Chief Mike Carnes says that this is not just about asking taxpayers for more money. The agency operates under a balanced budget and has passed all its completed audits by the state. (It is going through another regularly scheduled audit, which will be finished by the end of this year.)

The proposal would be on the November 6 General Election ballot and cost 21 cents per \$1,000 of assessed property value (or \$7.87 per month for the owner of a \$450,000 home). Since 2008, the levy rate has declined to \$1.29 which happens as property values rise to limit the fire district to roughly the same amount of revenue per year.

The fire district has actively pursued ways to save taxpayers money since 2008. It has improved its insurance rating with the Washington Surveying and Rating Bureau. This has saved many home and business owners on their annual insurance premiums.

ECFR relies on volunteers to provide some emergency services, which also saves on labor costs. It applies for grants to fund equipment and pays cash for emergency apparatus to avoid interest payments. It even paid off loans early and refinanced bonds, saving taxpayers \$250,000.

"We have done everything possible to delay the need for a Fire Levy lid lift," said Chief Mike Carnes. "However, call volumes have increased to the point that this is our only recourse."

The fire district has seen emergency call volumes increase 52 percent since 2007. The agency is allowed a one percent revenue increase per year by law. That amount is not keeping up with the cost of inflation which is currently 3-4 percent per year and some cost are even higher than that.

For example, utility costs have increased 18 percent in a year for the fire district. The cost for health insurance for district employees has increased 9.3 percent. Training for emergency personnel is 29.5 percent higher than the previous year. Higher call volumes also contribute to the amount the fire district pays in increased costs for operations, such as overtime (34.7 percent higher) and fuel for apparatus (23.4 percent).

Voters in East County Fire and Rescue originally approved a fire levy of \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed property value in 2008. More information about the lid lift can be found on the fire district's web site at <a href="https://www.ecfr.us">www.ecfr.us</a>.
